SALUTE TO THE FLAG

PUBLIC HEARING

Ordinance #08-12 - This ordinance would increase the water commodity charge per 100 cubic feet from \$4.51 to \$4.66.

Metro-Cast Cable Franchise - this hearing is part of the cable franchise renewal proceedings between the City of Franklin and MetroCast. This public hearing will help to ascertain the future cable related needs and interests of the community.

Proposed Economic Development Application/NH Community Development Block Grant - this application could be up to \$500,000 for economic development, public facility and housing projects. This application is on behalf of Big Cat Coffees, a growing business located in Franklin. The CDBG loan funds would be used to purchase machinery and equipment and would create up to 25 new jobs of which 60% of those jobs would be available to persons of low and moderate income. The City would retain up to \$22,000 for administrative costs and the remaining funds would be sub-granted to Capital Regional Development Council. CRDC would retain up to \$8,000 for service delivery costs and the balance of \$470,000 would go to Big Cat Coffees.
