Discussion of Priority Substances

The data provided three priority substances for two ages groups. The substances include Alcohol, Marijuana and Prescription Drugs among teenage youth and adults in their late 20's through mid-forties. Two sub-committees formed to begin detailing the risk factors for these substance being used and abused. One group focused on youth ages 12-19 and the other on adults 20-50. Both groups reconvened with risk factors, but the youth group was only able to make it through Prescription Drug use and will schedule follow-up meetings on February 9th and 16th to finish. A Drug Free Community Grant subcommittee will meet on February 18th to begin the application process.

There will be a few meetings scheduled through February for the youth group working on prioritizing strategies for the work plan and the Drug Free Communities Grant. A March coalition meeting will be scheduled later in February.
