**Contingency Grant Line Activity:** The City received the following in the contingent grant line this month:

\$15,000 from KaBoom for playground equipment  
\$2,353.43 from Odell Park Centennial for the basketball court  
\$250 from the Elks – to Parks & Rec with no specific purpose  
\$750 from the US Tennis Association (New England Chapter) for tennis equipment  
\$4,558.28 from State of NH for fire training

**Bessie Rowell Community Center update:**

Currently Tiny Twisters has received their licenses and occupancy permit and is operating in the Bessie Rowell community center! It was a very tight deadline for construction but we made it!! The rest of the building is closed off while we remain under construction. The Head Start project has just gone out to bid and I have recently begun meeting with the TRIP center and architect to finalize their plans for renovations to their section of the building.
