Contingency Grant Line Activity: The City received the following in the contingent grant line this month:

\$2,516.50 from Hurd Construction for the Webster Lake Project
\$319.97 from State of NH for Operation Safe Commute
\$100 from HealthTrust for wellness programs
\$29.21 from various for Santa Letters
\$200 from Rotary for book club
\$5,000 from charitable foundation for the Odell Cottage Plan
\$2,000 IPAD raffle for Police K9 fundraiser-for a total of \$6,139 raised to date from various events.
