Subject:

City Council to consider setting a Public Hearing on Ordinance #11-15, relative to a proposed Amendment to Chapter 284, Vehicles and Traffic, of

the Franklin City Code.

City Manager Recommendation: Schedule a public hearing with the following motion:

1. Mayor reads proposed Ordinance #11-15

2. Councilor moves:

"I move that the Franklin City Council schedule a public hearing on Ordinance #11-15 for Monday May 4, 2015 at 6:08 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Franklin City Hall."

3. Mayor calls for a second, discussion, and the vote.

Background: The City's Highway Safety Committee met on December 29, 2014. At this meeting changes to the City Code Chapter 284-24 entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" were discussed. It was decided to wait until early spring of 2015 to conduct a public hearing and ordinance changes on a couple of the agenda items that were not placed in previously approved Ordinance #08-15. Ordinance #11-15 proposes these additional items that the Committee desires to proceed with for setting a public hearing.

The first item involves changing the time limit and days that designate two hour and fifteen minute parking on sections of Central and Memorial Streets. A second proposed change is with regard to establishing Rowell Drive as a two way street.

In addition to opening up Rowell Drive to two way traffic is implementing "No Parking" on Rowell Drive the entire length. This is necessary because the road is only twenty four feet wide thus, that width will not accommodate on street parking if it is to be open to two way traffic. Also two additional stop signs are necessary to make the intersection of Rowell Drive and the entrance/exits to the Bessie Rowell Community Center safe for two way traffic. All of these recommendations are included in the proposed ordinance.

Citizen Participation: The opportunity for public input will take place at the public hearing scheduled for May 4, 2015. Additionally, the Highway Safety Committee met in a posted

meeting on Monday December 29, 2014 at which time public participation and comment are received on this and other topics.

Alternatives: The alternative is not set the public hearing allowing the process to move forward.

ORDINANCE #11-15

AN AMENDMENT TO THE FRANKLIN MUNICIPAL CODE:

In the Year of our Lord, Two Thousand Fifteen;

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Franklin that the Franklin Municipal Code, Chapter 284, Vehicles and Traffic, be changed as follows:

Article I
