City Council Meeting of January 5, 2015

Subject: City Council to consider approval of Ordinance #08-15 relative to a proposed Amendment to Chapter 284, Vehicles and Traffic, of the Franklin City Code.

City Manager Recommendation: Schedule a public hearing with the following motion:

1. Councilor moves:

“I move that the Franklin City Council approves Ordinance #08-15 concerning Chapter 284 Vehicles and Traffic of the Franklin City Code by a roll call vote.

2. Mayor calls for a second, discussion, and the vote.

Background: The City’s Highway Safety Committee has discussed and recommends changes to the City Code Chapter 284-24 “Vehicles and Traffic”.

The first proposed change is designating 16 overnight parking spaces, between the hours of 5:00 P.M. to 8:00 A.M, in the Municipal Parking Lot located off of Hancock Terrace adjacent to the Baptist Church.

A second proposed change is to add another fee to the “Fines” section of Chapter 284, creating a \$50.00 fine for the offence of parking on dead end streets that are designated under the code as limited or no parking.

The final proposed change to the code is to designate the current “Bus Stop” on Memorial Street and utilize the one remaining parking space as “Fifteen Minute Parking”. This practice is now in place and was done by means of a temporary traffic order but now needs to be codified.

Citizen Participation: The opportunity for any public input will take place at the public hearing scheduled for January 5, 2015. Additionally, the Highway Safety Committee met in a posted meeting on Monday November 17, 2014 at which there a public comment section.

Alternatives: The alternatives are to not approve this amendment, or turn the amendment over to the Council’s Legislative Committee for review and comment.

ORDINANCE #08-15

AN AMENDMENT TO THE FRANKLIN MUNICIPAL CODE:

In the Year of our Lord, Two Thousand Fourteen

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Franklin that the following additions will be made to Chapter 284, Vehicles and Traffic, Article I Traffic Signs and Controls, and Article II 284-20 Fines and 284-24 Limited Parking; No Parking Areas.

Note: *All additions are underlined and in italic.*

284-20 Fines

Fines shall be as follows:

Offense	Fine
<u>18. Dead end streets that are designated as limited or no parking</u>	<u>\$50.00</u>

284-24 Limited parking; no-parking areas

B. Fifteen-minute parking. Fifteen-minute parking areas are designed as follows:

Street	Section	Side
Memorial Street	336 Central Street North to <u>Memorial parking lot entrance</u> <u>(1 space)</u>	<u>Northeast</u>
