City Council to consider setting a Public Hearing on Ordinance # 06-16, relative to a proposed amendments to Chapter 284, "Vehicles and Traffic" of

the Franklin City Code.

#### **Recommended Motion:**

Councilor moves to set a public hearing:
 "I move that the Franklin City Council schedule a public hearing on Ordinance #06-16 for Monday October 5, 2015 at 6:08 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Franklin City Hall."

2. Mayor calls for a second, discussion, and the vote.

#### Background:

Attached for your review is a draft for proposed Ordinance #06-16. The intent of this Ordinance is to repeal and replace Ordinance #08-15 with Ordinance #06-16. The reason for the proposed repealing is that the titles for Article I and II of Ordinance #08-15 should be reversed to coincide with the proper sections of the current code. Also the proposed change to Section 284-24(D) was not codified as part of #08-15. The revised ordinance #06-16 reflect the necessary changes.

#### Concurrences:

These proposed Ordinance changes are agenda items at the August 17, 2015 Highway Safety Committee meeting and a Public Hearing to be scheduled for the October 5, 2015 with the Franklin City Council. The opportunity for public input can take place at both public meetings.

The Highway Safety Committee voted in favor of sending a positive recommendation to the Franklin City Council

#### **Fiscal Impact:**

#### Alternatives:

The proposal to repeal Ordinance #08-15 and replacing it with a new Ordinance #06-16 is a housekeeping measure that maintains continuity for those needing information from the "Vehicles and Traffic" Section 284 of the Franklin City Code. A positive recommendation will clarify any confusion that Ordinance #08-15 may present.

#### **ORDINANCE #06-16**

#### AN AMENDMENT TO THE FRANKLIN MUNICIPAL CODE:

In the Year of our Lord, Two Thousand Fifteen

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Franklin that the following additions/changes will be made to <u>Article I "Traffic Rules and Regulations" 284-20. Fines and Article II "Traffic Signs and Controls" 284-24 Limited Parking; no parking areas.</u>

Note: All additions are <u>underlined</u> and in italics.

<u>The intent of Ordinance #06-16 is to repeal Ordinance #08-15 in full and replace</u> it with Ordinance # 06-16.

Article I "Traffic Rules and Regulations" 284-20. Fines.

Fines shall be as follows:

18. Dead end streets that are designated \$50.00 as limited or no parking

Article II "Traffic Signs and Controls" 284-24- Limited parking; no-parking areas
