Contingency Grant Line Activity: The City received the following in the contingent grant line this month:

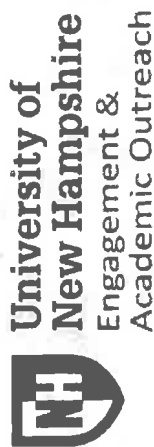
\$450 from Al's Village Pizza for field improvements
