VI. OLD BUSINESS

- 1. Selectmen reviewed the final 2015 Warrant for posting. Motion was made by Cordes to sign the Warrant. Hunter seconded and the vote was unanimous approved 2-0. The Warrant will be available for Holmes to sign later this evening or tomorrow.
- 2. Selectmen again discussed goals for 2015. This again included Capital Improvements planning, as well as rejuvenating Andy Kohlhofer's earlier energy regarding economic development. Selectmen discussed some of the Town and District's costs relative to cost per pupil, as well as the cost of other services.

The Board discussed meeting with the Planning Board to see about a group to spearhead an Economic Development Committee. The Board feels this is likely a long-term process.

Capital needs planning will need to begin with a capital needs assessment. The Town has some significant capital assets that need maintenance, upgrade, and at some point, replacement. There is a need to engage the community in this process.

3. Selectmen discussed potential photographs for the Town Report Cover, as well as the Appreciation page.

- 4. It is time again for annual review of several of the Board's policies. Selectmen asked for current versions to be sent out by email for review and discussion next week. Current review is needed of the Fraud, Credit Card, Investment, and Fund Balance Policies.
- 5. Repeat water tests for the month of January 2015 for the library water system were delivered to the NH State Lab on Monday.

VII. NEW BUSINESS

- 1. Selectmen reviewed the payroll \$19,226.33 and accounts payable manifest \$56,956.17 dated 16 January 2015. Within the accounts payable manifest, \$23,545.34 are bills paid for the 2014 calendar year.
- 2. Selectmen reviewed bills and invoices for payment.
- 3. Selectmen reviewed the folder of incoming correspondence. There was discussion about a request for flood data certification information for property at 259 Main Street, as well as a zoning violation at 16 Tibbetts Road.
- 4. The Board acknowledged a resignation letter from Tyra Vargas from the Fremont Budget Committee for health and work reasons, effective 01/13/2015. Cordes moved to accept the letter with regret. Hunter seconded and the vote was unanimously approved 2-0.
