Selectmen were in and out in the afternoon, primarily assisting voters with directions, and at times doing check-out and assisting with ballots collected in the voting machine. At the conclusion of polling hours, Board members sorted and assisted in counting the write-in ballots as needed.

Board members left the Ellis School at the conclusion of all after-polling counting and cleanup at approximately 10:00 pm.
