

## **Cable Committee Minutes**

**February 9, 2016**

Members present: Bruce White- Chairman, and Members Leo Danjou and Bill Millios

Chairmen's Report: The Chair reported on the live broadcast of the Town and School Deliberative Sessions from Ellis School. Particularly mentioned having success at toning down and/or eliminating the hollow sound we generally pick up at the gymnasium. The audio portion of the broadcasts and replays on Ch. 22 were a huge improvement from last year. Bruce also talked about the upcoming live broadcasts from the town library, Candidates night on February 29<sup>th</sup> and the Planning Board Public hearing on March 2<sup>nd</sup>. He also spoke about the second taping of the School Board coming up on February 16<sup>th</sup>.

The Budget report was postponed until the March meeting on the 8<sup>th</sup>.

Bruce made a motion to accept the minutes of the January Cable Committee Meeting, Bill seconded. Motion passed on a unanimous vote.

For discussion:

#1- Leo Danjou reported on an update on creating an FCTV facebook page. He made some progress but had some issues to overcome. Bill suggested getting together the following Tuesday before Parks and Recreation, to work together on the page.

#2- Bill Millios updated his progress on establishing a Vimeo account in order to give residents access to Board and Committee meetings by computer. He has been seeking advice from Marc and Kevin from RCTV. Both had positive suggestions. Bruce asked about the capacity of Vimeo based on their \$199.99 per year program. Bill said it would be more than enough to handle our monthly replays. Bill made a motion to purchase a DVR recorder for Vimeo. Bruce seconded and the vote was unanimous to approve the purchase. Bruce reminded Bill to get a receipt so he could get reimbursement from the Cable Revolving Fund. Bill was authorized to spend up to \$100 for said purchase. Bruce mentioned he had been getting numerous inquiries from residents about having access to replays of Board and Committee meetings and had told people the Committee was working on it and hoped to have something ready by the end of March.

With no additional business to discuss the meeting was adjourned at approximately 5:50 pm.
