

Fremont Open Space Committee Minutes – Aug 2, 2011

Approved November 1, 2011

- Meeting was convened at 7:10 PM. In attendance were J. Karcz, J. Downing, and D. Howland.
- Minutes May 3, 2011 were approved.
- Trail Maintenance and development report - D. Howland
 - Glen Oakes
 1. Link Parking sign installed at Link and Forest
 2. Forest Bypass trail between Forest and Homestead. Signed and Blazed
 - Oak Ridge
 1. Town Forest Ordinance signs (TFO) and Partner sign into Oak Ridge South Kiosk
 2. TFO and Partner sign in Oak Ridge North parking lot
 3. All trail intersections in the new network have sign posts with arrows indicating official trails. Some of the arrows also indicate shortest route to Tavern Road. Each post has a unique number which can be placed on trail map. SO as long as you follow arrows, you will eventually get back to Tavern Road. (In future, and if really needed, it would be possible to add signage indicated which way to go on Tavern to get to ORN parking lot.)
 - Money spent to date = \$93.11;
 - Short Term Plans
 1. Finish clearing and blazing new trail sections in Oak Ridge North
 2. In Glen Oakes, TFO signs on metal posts @ Barred Owl and power line, and at the Homestead Extension
 3. to be spent = ±\$10
- D. Howland to talk to Selectman about location of Oak Ridge Town Forest Sign and the potential for some town forest signage at major intersections near town forests.
- PSNH grant application being finalized for submission. This provides for additional signage, a kiosk in the Oak Ridge North parking area, and new trail maps for Oak Ridge.
