Mr. Karcz opened the meeting at 7:04 pm.

Unfortunately, the Planning Board did not have a quorum at this meeting. While unable to make any motions, the present members did discuss a few items on the agenda:

Ms. Rowden informed everyone present that at their next meeting, the Board should review the zoning recodification. When the Board is ready, they can then move it to public hearing for acceptance.

Mr. Karcz and Ms. Wolfe informed everyone that Marty Ferwerda's abutters were complaining about blasting on his property last week. There was a brief discussion about Ferwerda's site plan and conditions of his excavation permit renewal this year.

Due to a lack of a quorum, the public hearing for the proposed 145 foot monopole-style personal wireless service facility located at Map 1 Lot 12 did not occur. Mr. Karcz recommended that Mr. Sousa and his team look at Dan Tatem's letter, to address the Fire Chief's concerns, and to talk to the Road Agent. There was a short discussion about having test pits and the wetland delineation to be conditions of approval. The public hearing was continued to April 5th.
