CIP Update:

- The CIP Committee met and have approved 2 articles to move forward.
 - o ATM 11-39: Painting the Public Safety Building, \$20,000
 - o ATM 11-40: Replacement of Central Fire Station Garage Doors, \$22,000
- Balance in Capital Fund, \$35,000. The board is questioning this amount and will look into.
- ATM 11-39 will be paid out of the capital fund, ATM 11-40 will be financed over 2 years if the \$35,000 is the real balance.
