Minutes taken by Robin O'Malley

Mike Farrell updated the board:

- ♦ Handouts for FY10 Revenues and Expenditures through August 31, 2009.
- Revenue from the state is about \$85,000 short for FY10.
- Free Cash should be certified end of September to beginning of October
- ♦ The state primary, 12/8, and state election, 1/19, have an estimated cost of \$4,000 each. The town clerk's budget is not adequate and will need a reserve fund transfer to cover these costs.
- Fall town meeting is Monday, November 16, 2009

Robin received a letter from Pam Lundquist, coordinator for GeorgetownCARES, regarding the School Resource Officer and her support for the position.

The Finance Committee also received a memo from Glenn Smith, Water Superintendent. It is a list of the water department's capital improvement projects. The 9 projects are as follows:

- Rehab existing aging water wells
- Water transmission mains
- Aged infrastructure replacement
- Storage tank and booster
- Sulfate stripping facility
- Design and construct Longhill Water Tower
- Master meter replacement
- SOLAR residuals concentration facility
- ♦ Repair ops bldg and storage area
