- Valerio Romano- Attorney for Healthy Pharms: Healthy Pharms will be presenting technical aspects
 of the site plan and special permit application. We are making sure our proposal comports with the
- ⁹⁶ zoning by -law and special permit and site plan review procedure.

- 78 Tony Canetti- Hayes Engineering: We are applying under 2014 R&D Zoning bylaw. We picked the
- 99 former B&W Press building. We are doing very little to the outside of the site. We are adding rain
- 100 gardens and storm water enhancements. Once we receive Planning Board approval, we have to go
- 101 back to the Dept. of Public Health for an architectural review.
- 102
- 103 James Emmanuel- Landscape Architect: What we are doing to enhance the site is the rain garden to
- 104 capture storm water runoff. We will preserve the existing trees, and there will be no invasive
- 105 plantings. Wire mesh panels will be added to the building to improve the outward appearance of the
- 106 building. Vines on the wire mesh panels will provide a green screen.
- 107
- 108 Public comments in favor:
- 109 A resident expressed support for medical marijuana to treat her daughter's epilepsy. She shared
- 110 letters of support from 11 residents of Georgetown and surrounding communities. She asked that
- 111 the project move forward without delay.
- 112
- 113 Public comments opposed:
- 114 An abutter, ABC Storage, expressed concerns about the groundwater situation. They are concerned
- about the Georgetown/Rowley town lines regarding the water supply, the Rowley Water Resource
- Area, and who would be liable at the Georgetown/Rowley town line should there be any future
- 117 groundwater issues.
- 118
- 119 They expressed further concerns about their easements, the potential of a decrease in their property
- value, decrease in marketability and reputation, a negative perception by their customers, and the
- potential for abuse of marijuana at their property. They asked "How will Georgetown ensure that
- 122 the owners are properly managing groundwater?"
