Discussion took place about rescinding the Planning Boards desicion and it was stressed that time is an issue due to some of the land possibly (and more that likely probably) being owed by the town and under control of the Conservation Commission.

Mr. Thompson read excerpts from a letter from Town Counsel.

Mr. Gerraughty said that a licensed Engineer had stamped the plans originally submitted to the Planning Board and was unwilling to rescind any vote without written confirmation that the town does indeed own parts of the land used to create Caribou Court.

More discussion continued regarding acreage and past taxes paid and the time of the subdivision of the original property.

It was decided that the planning board would take all of the information under advisement until such time as the Selectman forwarded written conformation from Town Counsel or another certified Massachusetts engineer prepared another stamped plan of the parcel.
