- 2. Project Updates
  - a. JW met with Steve Przyjemski to discuss requirements and actions required related to the development of the maintenance plan. This plan will define how the trail will be cleared and maintained, and be sent to DEP.
  - b. In order to be ready for clearing of the trail at the appropriate time in the spring, CR will create a communication to send out to friends of the trail to organize a work crew following final approval of the maintenance plan.
  - To obtain construction funding, JW will create a proposal for the southern part of the trail and submit it to MVMPO.
  - d. To facilitate administrative control of the overall project the state has divided the project into 4 separate projects. The projects cover Salisbury, Byfield to Georgetown center, Georgetown center to Boxford town line and Boxford.
  - e. The expected schedule for the projects at this point is to hold the 25% design public hearings in June, 75% design to be completed by October and submit the NOI in November.
