Zoning Board of Appeals

There was a general discussion with several members of the ZBA regarding the operations and membership of the ZBA. There are still two openings on the board and the selectmen discussed possible candidates. Mr. Vincent mentioned that Scott MacDonald would be interested in serving on the ZBA.

Clark Street

Mr. Rich Coco, 1 Andover Street, was present to request that the Selectmen change the designation of Clark Street from "One Way" to "No Through Traffic". Mr. Coco's driveway is on Clark Street. Mr. Coco submitted a letter which detailed his request. The basis for the request relates to his inability to take a left out of his driveway in the direction of Andover Street. It was agreed that the matter would be referred to the Traffic Committee for a recommendation.

Energy Committee

Mr. Tardiff and Mr. Snow were present and gave the Selectmen an update regarding there effort to form an energy committee.

Library Parking

Member of the Library Building Committee, Library Trustees, Traffic Committee, Highway Surveyor, and several citizens were present to discuss the parking configuration at the new Library. Residents from Maple Street had suggested that several of the parking spaces on that side of the building could be moved to the other side of the building in order to lessen the traffic impact on Maple Street. After an extensive discussion it was the general consensus that any change in the approved traffic plan would necessitate a return to the Planning Board, which had approved the existing plan. The traffic committee offered to examine the overall traffic conditions in the area as part of their work plan.

Tag Sale at Harry Murch Park

Mr. Trapani <u>moved</u> and it was unanimously <u>voted</u> to allow the Georgetown All-Sports Boosters to hold a "tag sale" at Harry Murch Park on August 19, 2007, from 10:00 AM until 6:00 PM.
