The Town of Glenville, in partnership with County Waste, announces the *town-wide bulk waste pick-up* for all residents of the Town of Glenville, and outside the Village of Scotia. The trucks will begin collecting in your area on Monday, April 24th 2017. Residents are asked to place bulk items at the curb or along the edge of their property by 7:00 p.m. on the evening of **Sunday, April 23rd 2017**. There is no daily schedule by street so residents are asked to be patient with the collection process. \*Metal (Including Approved Appliances) must be placed in a separate pile from the items below. Metal items such as pipes etc. can be no longer than 6'.
