WHEREAS, a local law to amend Chapter 270 (Zoning) of the Code of the Town of Glenville, being proposed as Local Law No.1 – 2013, a copy of which is attached hereto, was introduced at this meeting by a member of the Town Board of the Town of Glenville at the recommendation of the Town of Glenville Building Department and the Town of Glenville Economic Development and Planning Department; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the proposed Local Law amendments to the Code, involving the regulation of signs, include the addition of new and modified provisions that are meant to acknowledge the evolution of new sign materials and lighting methods; add provisions for sign types that weren't contemplated when the current zoning law was first adopted in 2001 (i.e. LED signs and sandwich board signs); and modifications to correct conflicting provisions; and

WHEREAS, New York State Town Law and the Code of the Town of Glenville require a public hearing before the Town Board before a Local Law

may be adopted and the Town Board desires to schedule same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Glenville hereby schedules a public hearing for Wednesday, February 6, 2013 at 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached, at the Town of Glenville Municipal Center, at which time and place it will hear all persons interested in the adoption of Local Law No. 1-2013, an amendment to Chapter 270 (Zoning) of the Town of Glenville, relative to the regulation of signs; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Town Clerk be, and she hereby is directed to prepare the proper notice of said hearing in accordance with law and to publish same at least 10 days prior to the date of the public hearing.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the resolution adopting the Local Law shall take effect when filed with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Glenville has been considering a Local Law to amend Chapter 255, "Vehicle and Traffic" of the Code of the Town of Glenville; and

WHEREAS, this Town Board has held a public hearing on December 19, 2012 at 7:30 P.M., at which time all parties in interest were afforded an opportunity to be heard and to publicly comment on the amending of the Code of the Town of Glenville as set forth above:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Town Board of the Town of Glenville does hereby establish a local law to amend the Code of the Town of Glenville to adopt Local Law #6 of 2012, an amendment to Chapter 255, "Vehicle and Traffic" as set forth below:

## ADD:

The following intersections are hereby designated as stop intersections and stop signs shall be erected on entrances thereto as indicated:
