I expect to have a slate of candidates ready for your consideration next month in anticipation of appointments for the organizational meeting in January. There are a few other committees too that people will be coming forth on those as well.

Jamie was able to attend, I had a last minute change in my schedule and I could not make the Center for Economic Growth (CEG) meeting yesterday. The topics covered by the panel, as Jamie reports, were economic development in the outlook for the coming year. What was talked about was community preparation for economic development, coordination among economic development agencies, barriers to local government economic development effort including how the tax cap limits the community to be able to invest in projects and predictability of a town's process and preparedness for keys to local community economic development success.

Small Business Economic Development Committee recently reviewed the draft marketing message prepared by the town's consultants, PC Public Affairs. He said he was quite pleased with the message which is incorporated in comments by the SBED prior to the formal acceptance."

WHEREAS, a written petition has been presented to and filed with the Town Clerk of the Town of Glenville requesting an extension to Water District No.11 of the Town of Glenville be established to include real property described by section, block and lot number in the petition and consisting of one parcel located at 149 Hetcheltown Road in the Town of Glenville; and

WHEREAS, a map, plan and report prepared by Lansing Engineering, Professional Engineers with a date of November 2012, was been filed in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Glenville in conjunction with Extension 39 to Water District 11 which anticipated the addition of the subject property; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Glenville hereby adopts the following order:

ORDER

- 1. A petition to add an Extension to Water District No. 11 from the existing water main's terminal point just south of the southerly lot line of 147 Hetcheltown Road to a point about 266 feet north to the premises at 149 Hetcheltown Road has been filed with the Town Clerk on or about May 20, 2011.
- 2. The real property to be included in the extension is described by section, block and lot number as identified on the Schenectady County Real Property Tax Service Agency Tax Map as: 16.9-4-5.
- 3. The improvements proposed are the installation of approximately 266 feet of 12 inch ductile iron pipe water main and a one inch lateral connection to the main for an individual service connection along the route described in "1" as indicated above.
- 4. The amount proposed to be expended for the extension is approximately \$26,000.00 to be borne entirely by the developer.
- 5. While the improvements may benefit other users in the future, no portion of the

cost this extension will be attributable to Water District No.11.

6. The estimated annual cost to the typical property is:

a. District: \$77.92 b. O & M: \$0.00

- 7. The map, plan and report describing extension 39 to Water District 11 which references this potential extension is on file in the Town Clerk's Office and may be inspected by members of the public.
- 8. The proposed financing method to be employed in the construction of this connection in this water district extension is private financing by the developer.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Glenville will hold a public hearing on the petition to establish this extension to Water District No. 11 on December 5, 2012 at 7:30 PM or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached, at the Glenville Municipal Center at 18 Glenridge Road, Glenville, New York to hear all persons interested in the establishment of this extension to the water district; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this order certified by the Town Clerk shall be published at least once in the official newspaper of the Town and that said publication be not less than ten nor more than twenty days before the December 5, 2012 public hearing date.
