

Morgan St. Water Line Project: Commission approved removal of straw bales and silt fence as determined from a recent site visit.

New Business

BS read letter from Building Inspector regarding pumping of water at 12 Ken Lane which has resulted in a complaint from neighbor at 14 Ken Lane (Gaspari). Building inspector also has concerns regarding fence permit requested by Mr. Jimmo as area may be within a wetland. Building inspector would like representative from commission to be at wetland delineation required for issuance of permit.

Mr. Jimmo alleges sump pump water is being discharged onto his property by another neighbor, water is then flowing onto Mrs. Gaspari's property. Suggested a neutral party from the Commission come out to property to view.

Mrs. Gaspari then voiced concerns about pipe & proposed fence, wants pipe moved so that it won't flow onto her property.

PK pointed out that because neighbor is 3rd party to the issue and not present, we can't endorse any changes to pipe placement.

BS proposed DW as impartial observer, WL offered to be second as witness at site visit because of her experience with wetland delineation.

CC will need to contact 3rd party before going onto her property during a site visit.
