Warrant Articles # 1 & 2 Town of Granby General By-laws.

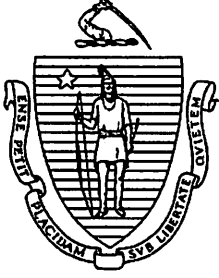
Article # 1- to amend the Bylaws of the Town of Granby Volume I by inserting Chapter I-a Town Moderator as follows:

Article # 2- “to accept the provisions of MGL Chapter 40 Sec 22F and amend the Bylaws of the Town of Granby volume I by deleting Section 2 of Chapter XVIII Fees.

Articles 1 and 2 – We approve Articles 1 and 2 from the June 16, 2014 Granby Special Town Meeting.

Note: Pursuant to G.L. c. 40, § 32, neither general nor zoning by-laws take effect unless the town has first satisfied the posting/publishing requirements of that statute. Once this statutory duty is fulfilled, (1) general by-laws and amendments take effect on the date that these posting and publishing requirements are satisfied unless a later effective date is prescribed in the by-law, and (2) zoning by-laws and amendments are deemed to have taken effect from the date they were voted by Town Meeting, unless a later effective date is prescribed in the by-law.
