

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

TITLE: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Hearing

BACKGROUND: Pursuant to the Community Development Strategy and Master Plan, Great Barrington is working with the Town of Sheffield to apply for CDBG funds from the Massachusetts Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD). This public hearing is intended to ensure that the community has an opportunity to learn about the intended application and provide input if they desire.

The application will include a one activity in each town, and one joint, two-town activity, as follows:


- The Town of Sheffield will seek funds to provide handicapped access to their Town Hall. Sheffield will be the lead town for this year's effort and will administer the grant with the assistance of the Berkshire Regional Planning Commission.
- The Town of Great Barrington will seek funds for work at the former Housatonic School. Work will include environmental assessment and site engineering services to facilitate the removal of environmental contaminants and/or treatment of such contaminants to render them harmless. This work will continue the Town's effort to remove slum and blight in the village.
- The two towns will seek a grant to support the regional Housing Rehabilitation Program. This will continue the successful program begun under the 2014 grant that provides assistance to low- and moderate-income homeowners.

The Towns will enter into an inter-local agreement to govern their relative roles and responsibilities under the grant. This is similar to what was done for the 2014 grant.

FISCAL IMPACT: Most of the administrative costs and overall management will be provided by BRPC and the Town of Sheffield, and paid for with the grant funds.

RECOMMENDATION: Vote to support the 2016 Community Development Block Grant application as outlined, to authorize the Town Manager to enter into an inter-local agreement with Sheffield for this purpose, and to authorize the Town Manager to sign the relevant grant application documents.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

TITLE: Application to the Berkshire Regional Planning Commission (BRPC) for District Local Technical Assistance (DLTA) grants

BACKGROUND: The BRPC receives funds from the state each year to provide free technical assistance to communities on eligible projects. Communities do not receive the funds directly; rather, the BPRC staff does the work, which is above and beyond what the municipalities can usually do alone. Some examples of past DLTA projects in Great Barrington include a Housing Needs Study, zoning review in Housatonic, Master Plan technical assistance including development sites. Proposals are simple one-page narratives.


This year Great Barrington will seek DLTA for:

- Assistance relative to “Smart Growth” zoning for multi-family housing. This is a project the Planning Board has been studying under a different grant program and looks forward to discussing with the Selectboard in the coming year.
- Assistance relative to economic development research. There is scant business/industry data available on the local level, and BRPC would develop and help administer a survey to gather important economic data.
