EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

TITLE: Public Hearing and setting of the FY 2017 sewer rates by the Selectboard acting as the Sewer Commissioners.

BACKGROUND: The Selectboard, Finance Committee and Town Meeting have approved the FY 2017 sewer enterprise fund budget. Massachusetts General Law requires that the Selectboard advertise and hold a hearing to determine the sewer rates for FY 2017. Massachusetts Department of Revenue also requires that the Board set the allocation of the indirect costs for personnel appropriated as part of the general fund operating budget to be transferred to the enterprise fund and included in the sewer rate. This transfer of \$81,000 was approved at the final public hearing in the budget process by the Selectboard and the Finance Committee.

FISCAL IMPACT: The sewer enterprise fund budget is \$1,662,229 for direct costs as approved by Town Meeting. The indirect costs for the following personnel are approximately: Joe Sokul 25%, Amy Pulver 10%, Jennifer Tabakin 8%, Lauren Sartori Hobgood 6%, Karen Fink 10% and Debbie Ball 20% for both salary and related benefits is \$81,000. The total budget is \$1,743,229. Sewer rates fund approximately 90% of the budget with the remaining funds coming from septic charges and other fees. The enterprise fund is fully self-supporting with only users paying for the costs. The current sewer rate is \$460 per equivalent dwelling unit (EDU). **No rate increase is necessary to fund the FY 2017 operations.**

RECOMMENDATION: That the Selectboard acting as the Sewer Commissioners vote to set the sewer rate at \$460 per EDU and approve the allocation of the indirect costs in the amount of \$81,000 for FY 2017 to fund the enterprise fund costs.



- 1. The applicant shall construct the proposed access to conform to the following applicable criteria listed under **Section 153-14**, **Design requirements** of the Town of Great Barrington Code::
 - B. <u>Driveway location</u> as shown on the attached plan is acceptable, with regards to alignments with the way, profile, sight distance conditions and not located at the extreme edge of the property.
 - C. <u>No more than two</u> (2) driveways shall normally be allowed for any property, unless there is a clear necessity for more.
 - D. Driveways shall not normally be approved <u>at intersections</u>, because of potential safety hazards.
 - E. <u>Culverts</u> taking the place of roadside ditches shall have a diameter of not less than 15" (A culvert is not required at this location)
 - F. <u>Entrance elevation</u> at the point of entry into the public right-of-way shall be no more than the elevation of the shoulder of the road.
 - G. Driveways should be so constructed that water from the driveway shall not drain onto the crown of the road.
 - H. In no instance shall the edge of the driveway entering onto the road conflict with the flow of surface water runoff.

- I. <u>Driveway width</u> shall not be less than 8-feet or more than 16-feet within the town right-of-way. Any curb at the entrance shall be rounded off with a radius of three (3) feet.
- J. <u>Pitch of driveway</u> shall be downward from the edge of the road to sideline of the town right-of-way or front property line.
- K. Driveways should be located to the best advantage with respect to the alignment with the way, profile and sight distance conditions. In no instance shall a driveway intersect the way at less than a sixty degree angle. Unless there is no alternative, a driveway should not be located within a required side yard.
- L. No permit shall be issued for any driveway to a structure or proposed structure on a grade in excess of ten percent (10%) above the road or street level until and unless the applicant submits plans to the Highway Superintendent showing that the driveway will be constructed in a such a way so as not to discharge water, stones or other materials onto any public street, road or highway.

(A stone Swale shall be installed on the West side of the Driveway Down to a Drainage area at the lowest part of the Property) (See attached Sketch)

- 2. Install a paved driveway apron in accordance with the following requirements:
 - A. Apron dimensions: Width = 22-feet maximum along the roadway which includes a 3-foot radius curb on each side. Length = 5-feet minimum from edge of roadway.
 - B. Place 3-inches of bituminous concrete on 12-inches of compacted gravel.
 - C. Place asphalt tack coat along the edge of the road where the apron meets the edge of the existing pavement.


The applicant agrees to notify the Highway Superintendent (528-2500) at least 48 hours prior to the installation of the paved apron.

- 3. Should there be, after completion of the driveway, discharges of water, stones, or silt onto the public way or onto property of any abutters or neighbors, the property owner shall take whatever steps are necessary to eliminate such discharges.
- 4. The applicant shall maintain the proposed access to conform to the following applicable condition listed under **Section 153-17**, **Continuing responsibility of owners**, of the Town of Great Barrington Code:

Abutting property owners shall be responsible for keeping culverts under their driveways cleared and for maintaining driveways in condition conforming to the requirements of the permit.

The Great Barrington Rotary Club would once again like to ask for your support with our 4th annual Bike-N-Fly cycling event. We are asking for written consent so we can forward to Mass DOT. We will contact the police and fire departments from your town and abide by any of their requirements.

The ride would start and end at the Great Barrington Airport and would be in conjunction with the Fly-In event. The date would be August 20th 2016. I have included a course map for all routes that we would like to include in this years event. The cyclists would start the ride at 9:00 am and most riders will return within 2 to 3 hours. We will provide a sweeper vehicle to pick up riders after 4 hours.

The courses have been set up with safety in mind. We have avoided as many left turns as possible to keep the bikes from crossing against traffic. We have also tried to stay away from heavy traffic areas. The Rotary will have course monitors at intersections to keep the riders safe and to make sure they are following traffic laws. 



TITLE: Extension of Agreement between CET and the Town of Great Barrington for the Collection of Hazardous Waste Through the Multi-Town Collaborative.

BACKGROUND: Each year the Town signs a letter of intent to continue participation in the Berkshire County Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program. The Town also signs an agreement with the Center for EcoTechnology (CET) to coordinate and administer the program as part of the multi-town HHW collection program. The Town carries a line in the annual budget to pay for the fees for this program.

FISCAL: The estimated fee based on the Town of Great Barrington's population is \$3,661. The proposed FY17 budget for this program is \$6,500 which includes collection fees beyond this program.

RECOMMENDATION: Great Barrington continues to be one of the leaders for this program in the County. It is recommended that the Selectboard approve the continued participation in the program and have the appropriate authority sign the agreement.

The parties also agree to submit the first installment of 20% of the annual fee by July 15, 2016. Attachment A stipulating the annual budget and payment is enclosed.

We look forward to the fifteenth year of the South Berkshire Regional Household Hazardous Waste Collaborative for the collection of household hazardous waste.
