Subject: Proposed changes to inspection fees

During FY17 budget meetings there was discussion of updating the Fire Department's permit and inspection fee schedule. Attached is my proposed revision. Our current system has different rates for all permits and inspections. My proposal makes all fees the same - \$10 for permits and \$40 for inspections. This is consistent with fees charged by departments both locally and across the state.

The major change is including a plan review fee which is not done currently. I dedicate hundreds of hours each year to consulting with developers, engineers, and contractors, reviewing plans, and performing inspections on projects. The town is not compensated for any of my time. The proposed fee is similar the building department. The fee is based on the cost of the project at \$0.75 per \$1,000. The proposed minimum is \$40 and maximum \$4,000. An additional \$0.50 per \$1,000 is charged if the project includes a sprinkler system. The fee not only covers the plan review but also all inspections up through the completion of the project.

Currently the town only collects about \$14,000 a year in fire inspection fees. By increasing the cost of all inspections to \$40 I predict an increase of \$4,000 to \$18,000. The plan review fee should generate an additional \$15,000 to \$25,000 per year, estimated based on permits issued by the building department over the past two years. Total revenues generated by the fire department should be around \$40,000 annually with substantially more some years when large construction projects are permitted.

#### **Event Plan**

Date: August 3, 2017 Time: 16:00-21:00

Event Coordinators: Terry Chamberland & Joseph Bozza

#### Description

Downtown streets will be used for a car show displaying all types of motorized vehicles with vendors set up along the sidewalks selling food and other merchandise. Olde Yankee Street Rods will play recorded music through speakers set up on Main Street. 250-350 show cars are expected with several thousand people over the course of the night.

#### Command Post

Command post will be located at Railroad and Main Streets

#### **Display Parking**

<u>Locations:</u> Main Street from Castle Street to Cottage Street, Castle Street, Railroad Street, and in front of the Town Hall.

<u>Priority:</u> Vehicles will first be parked on Main Street from Elm to Castle, then Castle Street, Railroad Street, and in front of the Town Hall. Cars will then be parked on Main Street north of Elm Street as far as needed. Vintage fire apparatus will park in front of the old fire house. In service apparatus will park on the south side of Castle Street.

Reserving Parking: The DPW will line the sidewalks with cones during the morning. Event workers will use the cones to reserve parking spaces as they open up starting at 14:00. All cars must remain properly parked until the road is closed at 15:45. At that time cars will be allowed to diagonally park on Main Street. They must be properly parked by 21:00 when the road is re-opened or they will be towed. Planters: Care will be taken to avoid pedestrians trampling the newly planted plants on Main Street. Cars will be parked to allow spectators to walk around vehicles without stepping in the planters.

#### **Public Parking**

We are working with the owners of several downtown parking lots to lift parking restriction on their lots at 16:00 p.m. to ensure adequate parking for the public.

#### Security

There will be police officers at both ends of the event for traffic details. No additional security is planned.

#### Traffic

<u>Detour:</u> Main Street will be shut down from Castle Street to Cottage Street. North bound traffic will be diverted down Bridge Street and across East Street. South Bound traffic will be diverted down Cottage Street, across East Street, and back up Bridge Street.

<u>Detail Officers:</u> Two police details will be located at Main/Bridge, one at East/Cottage, and one at Main/Cottage. The stop signs on East Street at the Cottage Street intersection will be covered to facilitate a steady traffic flow.

Emergency Access: All roads will remain accessible for emergency vehicle access.

Tractor Trailers: Crews of firefighters will slowly escort tractor trailers through Main Street during the event to alleviate congestion through the detour.

Local Traffic: Church and Pleasant Streets will be coned off at Main Street. Rosseter Street and Dresser Ave will be diverted north on Main Street. Any necessary local traffic will be escorted by firefighters to their destinations.

Handicap: All disabled people requesting special accommodations in reaching a destination within the event area will be accommodated. The crews assisting tractor trailers will escort them to their destination. Either a convenient parking location will be found or a valet service will be offered. Parking options will be upper Railroad Street and the Berkshire Bank lot.

#### **EMS**

SBVAS will have a rig mobile posted at the event, but not committed. No elevated hazards are anticipated.

#### Fire/Rescue

An engine, ladder, and rescue will be staged and in service on Castle Street. No elevated hazards are anticipated.

#### Communications

Event: Fire Ground 3

Traffic (Truck Escorts): Fire Ground 3—a mobile radio will be used to communicate from Castle Street to Cottage Street.

Traffic (Police Details): Central

Emergency: Standard dispatch and communications policies will remain in effect for police, fire, and EMS.



#### Vendors

Locations: Venders are being coordinated with the Chamber of Commerce. They will be located so as to not block or obstruct access to any open business or occupied building.



Permit: It is the responsibility of the vendor to obtain all necessary permits for their operations.

#### Restrooms

Accessible porta pottles will be located in front of 297 Main Street and 244 Main Street.



The Great Barrington Rotary Club would once again like to ask for your support with our 5th annual Bike-N-Fly cycling event. We are asking for written consent so we can forward to Mass DOT. We will contact the police and fire departments from your town and abide by any of their requirements.

The ride would start and end at the Great Barrington Airport and would be in conjunction with the Fly-In event. The date would be **August 19th 2017**. I have included a course map for all routes that we would like to include in this years event. The cyclists would start the ride at 9:00 am and most riders will return within 2 to 3 hours. We will provide a sweeper vehicle to pick up riders after 4 hours.

The courses have been set up with safety in mind. We have avoided as many left turns as possible to keep the bikes from crossing against traffic. We have also tried to stay away from heavy traffic areas. The Rotary will have course monitors at intersections to keep the riders safe and to make sure they are following traffic laws. This year's event is not a timed race, it will be just a ride. We will have EMS volunteers with CPR and first aid training on the route as ride marshals. The ride marshals act as safety ambassadors by sharing cycling advice and encouraging safe cycling behaviors. 



Chapter 41 OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF CITIES, TOWNS AND DISTRICTS

Section 11 APPOINTMENT TO FILL VACANCY IN TOWN OFFICE

Section 11. As used in this section, the term "vacancy" includes a failure to elect. If a vacancy occurs in any town office, other than the office of selectman, town clerk, treasurer, collector of taxes or auditor, the selectmen shall in writing appoint a person to fill such vacancy. If there is a vacancy in a board consisting of two or more members, except a board whose members have been elected by proportional representation under chapter fifty-four A, the remaining members shall give written notice thereof, within one month of said vacancy, to the selectmen, who, with the remaining member or members of such board, shall, after one week's notice, fill such vacancy by roll call vote. The selectmen shall fill such vacancy if such board fails to give said notice within the time herein specified. A majority of the votes of the officers entitled to vote shall be necessary to such election. The person so appointed
