WPA NOI 167-0369 from Dave Inglis of Mahaiwe Harvest located on South Main Street, Map 37 Lot 93 for new agriculture in the resource area of the Green River, a NHESP habitat and a 100 year flood plain. **Continued from August 28, 2013.** Update on progress.

WPA NOI 167- 0387 from Tighe & Bond for the Town of Great Barrington Department of Public Works. The work includes the replacement of a retaining wall on Route 41, #4-6 North Plain Road, just west of the Housatonic Railroad underpass.

WPA NOI 167-0386 from Berkshire Engineering for Butternut Basin, Inc. at 380 State Road, Map 42 Lot 2. The work includes replacement of metal culvert under the driveway with a 3 ft. concrete drain leading to the pond. Also beefing up treatment in the stormwater system feeding into this drain. **Continued from August 27, 2014.**

Requests for Certificates of Compliance, DEP Files #167-0206 and #167-0342, from White Engineering for John Delmolino, White House Square, 325 & 389 Stockbridge Road, Map 8 Lots 4 & 2.

Request for an Amended Order of Conditions (DEP File 167-0376) from White Engineering for Moses Clark LLC, property at 518 Egremont Road, Map 31 Lot 101. Reflecting revised house renovations, new footprints for house & garage, new man-made pond on the property, and erosion controls throughout to be modified accordingly.

WPA NOI 167-0385 Kirt Mayland of Housatonic Solar 1, LLC and Michael Marcus of New England Environmental will update the Commission on various aspects of the project including discussions with the Natural Heritage and Endangered Species program staff concerning turtle habitat & buffer area on Neenah Paper property and revisions to the proposed cutting plan. **Continued from May 28, 2014.**
