7:00 RDA – Lake Mansfield Conservation Forest/Dehon Road, filed by the Lake Mansfield Alliance/project of the Great Barrington Land Conservancy. Proposed project involved the winter removal and transport of available lumber from the Lake Mansfield Conservation Forest to the Lake Mansfield parking area by use of people, horse, and oxen power.

7:10 RDA SMA – 326 Long Pond Road, filed by Alexander Sarbib. Proposed work includes grading and seeding a previously cleared area, and the removal of trees.

7:20 RDA – 389 Stockbridge Road, filed by John Delmolino. The proposed project will include the construction of walls to close in an open pavilion.

7:30 NOI – Maple Avenue, Map 30, Lot 45, DEP file # 167-0343, filed by George Beebe, continued. The proposed project will provide flood protection and bank stabilization along approximately 600 feet of the left bank of the Green River while providing excess compensatory flood storage.

7:40 RDA – 88 Christian Hill Road, filed by Allegrone Homes Inc. Proposed work includes the installation of an inground pool, spa, and associated landscaping. The work is within the buffer zone of a Bordering Vegetated Westland and the riparian zone of an intermittent stream.

7:50 NOI – Rising Pond Dam, filed by the General Electric Company. Proposed work for maintenance repair of the dam includes the installation of sheet piling at the upstream crest of the right westerly dam embankment to reinforce and prevent seepage and internal erosion within the embankment.
