1:00 pm – WPA Notice of Intent 167-0374 from 53 Brookside Rd., Great Barrington; URJ Camp Eisner to install a new water line from Grove Street through a portion of land owned by John Dewey Academy and directed southerly onto and through the land of Camp Eisner. Special conditions required by the Natural Heritage and Endangered Species Program were reviewed and will be included in the Order of Conditions. These included having state listed plant species located by a professional botanist and fenced off to prohibit construction activity in the special plant habitat areas. Excavation in these areas to be prohibited, and instead, the pipeline is to be installed by boring beneath the special habitat areas, keeping equipment well away from the fenced-in areas.
