- b. The Committee reviewed a sign permit application submitted on behalf of Dempsey Physical Therapy. The sign would consist of acrylic letters individually mounted in masonry. The sign would be 16.66 square feet on each side. It will not be illuminated.

- c. The Committee discussed a sign application submitted by Carrie Herrington for her business, Wear House, located at 24 Railroad Street. Sign builder Ryan Larkin was present with Ms. Herrington. The discussion of the sign involved the sign color which would be grey and white. There are currently two spot lights that would illuminate the sign.

Mr. Okerstrom Lang said it is important for the light source to not be seen so the lights would have to be shielded.

After further discussion Mr. Hankin said there were issues such as the lighting that should be settled and the application should be resubmitted with additional information including details of the lettering.

The applicant thanked the Committee for their time.
