Update to BOS and related bodies: deferred

Updates on Recreational Area Maintenance:

- 1. J. Sokul (DPW superintendent): Early start on cleanup then returning to seasonal maintenance. Stakes may be set around new elderberry/blueberry bushes before mowing to help designate the space as a no-mowing area to allow for the revitalization of the buffer zone.
- 2. Mowing Guidelines (prepared by D. Abrams) **See attached** derived from old set promulgated by Con Com. Area divided into three mowing zones: regular, limited and none. Guidelines to be reviewed by J. Sokul for feasibility, then by Con Com, and then adopted by DPW.
- 3. Lake Mansfield Road: Question of how to discourage parking at Floyd property.
- 4. Beach Area Improvements: new sign at lifeguard station, second (seasonal) lifeguard chair, better fastening for anti-weed fabric (paid for by Parks Commission) in swim area.
- 5. RDA for Invasive Weed Control (Lake Mansfield Alliance): submitted by D. Abrams to Con Com. Purpose: cutting of bittersweet, loosestrife and non-native Phragmites.
- Trail Developments: use review for accessible vehicles- C. Ward.
 Spring trail work will include connection with Christian Hill Commons.

Grant Updates:

604b Planning Grant for engineering of Knob Hill storm water mitigation contracted to Foresight Services. Support for boat launch improvements sought from MA Fishing & Access.

319 Non-point Source Pollution Grant for Castle hill storm water filtration: contract to arrive momentarily; work scheduled for 2012-13.
