I. Call to Order: Meeting called to order at 5:32 pm.

b. Approval of December minutes: HBS motion to approve December minutes, DC second. Vote 5-0.

c. Trustee Announcements: KP announced that she has written a letter to the Tree Committee regarding the tree that Tom Ingersoll is interested in donating to Mason Library. The donation, the removal of the current tree and the planting of the new tree will first need to go through the Tree Committee, then the Selectboard and then DPW. KP will follow up.

II. Reports of Officers, Boards, and Standing Committees

a. Director's Report: AD (see attached report). PH asked about basement lights at Ramsdell as he noticed they had been on in the evening. PH suggested investigating a sensor for those lights.
