Terms for participation in the Blueberry Jamboree, August 6th, 2011

1. The Blueberry Jamboree is a family friendly fair intended to celebrate Greenfield's contribution of the high -bush blueberry to American agriculture.
2. The entry fee of up to \$25.00 entitles you to one 12' X 12' space. Spaces may be shared by more than one vendor at no additional cost.
**Electricity is available for an additional \$10.00 fee, spaces are limited and given on a first come first serve basis.*
Fee is non-refundable. Event will be held rain or shine. Vendor must participate for the entire duration of the event-NO EARLY BREAK DOWN.
3. 12'x12' space maximum (own set-up, i.e., table, chairs, tent etc. is vendors responsibility). Free Vehicle parking available at Oak Park. If you wish to park by your space, it must be reserved when this application is filed. Only one (1) vehicle per 12'x12' space. Car can not be moved during event.
4. All vendor items are to be displayed within these spaces, not in aisles, walkways, or exits.
5. Applications must be postmarked by **July 1st**, or the participant fee increases to \$30.00. **Please be sure to include:**

6. You will receive your assigned location and detailed instructions in the self address stamped envelope provided with this application 10 DAYS PROIR to the event, or your application fee will be returned to you by July 24th, 2011.
7. Vendor participants please note: Space is assigned on a first come first serve basis. If more than one participant applies to be in the fair that owns the same type of business every effort will be made to keep variety throughout the fair and direct competition at a minimum.
8. Set up time is 7:00 a.m. to 8:45 a.m. Saturday, August 6th, 2011. You will need to check in at the information booth before 8:45 a.m. or you will be considered a "no show" and we reserve the right to fill your space with another vendor.
9. Vendor is responsible for their displays, providing their own cash boxes, and monitoring their own space.
10. Vendor will remove all trash, boxes, etc. , from their booth before leaving.
11. Vendors may choose to donate an item to benefit Oak Park. Participation is optional. Item will be collected the day of the event. Vendor will receive additional advertising at the raffle table for their in-kind donation.
12. The Town of Greenfield, and/or the Blueberry Jamboree Committee will not be responsible for the loss, theft of, or damage to vendor's items or for personal injury or the loss of money during the Blueberry Jamboree. By signing Page 1 of the application you agree to the terms listed above.
