If you can, bring them to the Recycling Center along with your blue bags between noon and 4pm. If you can't, please leave them along the road in a pile. That's all there is to it. It's quick and easy, AND you can feel good about doing something to keep Greenfield clean and beautiful.

There are many of you that want to do more to help. If you need extra blue bags, you may find them at the Recycling Center during the week before the Round-Up. It would be greatly appreciated, if you would not only bring your full blue bags but any others you see, and any other items you see along the road, to the Recycling Center. The Conservation Commission will be collecting all the blue bags and any other debris at a special collection station right at the Recycling Center on April 21st. Look for a dumpster just for Roadside Round-Up trash. This will allow us to keep track of just how much trash we collect so that we know what a success this event has been.
