What YOU do:

- ⤴ refer to a book’s title, characters, illustrations (puns are entirely welcome) you may include book with display if you like.
- ⤴ Be inspired by a book’s plot or quote from the story.
- ⤴ be in the shape of an actual book (or eBook, or scroll, etc.)
- ⤴ Stephenson Memorial Library Inspirations or memories are welcome

Register at Drop Off ten am, Saturday, July 27th , Wensberg Room, , Sign in with your name/contact & title/description”. Non-refrigerated space please plan accordingly and present your entry on a sturdy platform.

By entering this contest, the creator of the edible book is giving the Library permission to photograph and publish information on the creation and its creator on the library's Facebook page and local publications. All entries must be family friendly. The Library reserves the right to reject any entries which are considered to be inappropriate.

Deadline: Drop off entries by 10 am, Saturday, July 27th, Wensberg Room, Stephenson Memorial Library, 761 Forest Road, Greenfield, NH 03047,

What WE do: Based on all the entries Library staff, trustees, friends and attendees vote. Staff will “count” votes based on NON-TASTING elements only.

Fine Print: You can enter as many times as you like, but you can only win one prize. Your dish must be made of edible ingredients (no hats, lost-wax sculptures, performance art), and by entering the contest you certify that it is your own creation.
