# Guidelines for Participation in Greenfield NH's 225th Anniversary Parade

- 1. Entrants must observe all applicable rules and regulations and follow instructions from police and parade officials.
- 2. Vehicles will not be allowed in the parade unless pulling a float, providing transportation for entrants or entered as an antique vehicle or other organized specialty car groups with prior approval.
- 3. To prevent any injuries to parade participants or spectators, the throwing of candy and other parade- friendly items must be done by walking participants ONLY.
- 4. A space of 20 feet between each unit is recommended.
- 5. Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any float, in any vehicle, or on the person of any participant.
- 6. Drivers of any and all vehicles in the parade areas must possess a valid driver's license, be at least 18 years old, and possess all liability vehicle insurance.
- 7. Livestock and domestic animals must be crowd friendly, healthy, and up to date on vaccinations.
- 8. The use of high intensity sound making devices is strongly discouraged.
- 9. The 225th Anniversary Committee does not accept the responsibility for travel, food, or lodging expense of any unit.

#### **FLOATS**

- 1. Vehicles that are pulling floats should be incorporated as much as possible into the float and decorated accordingly.
- 2. All floats must have handholds or standup holds for each rider on the float. Any self-propelled float must have a spotter beside the float.
- 3. No participants may jump on or off a float while traveling the parade route, nor interfere with any other unit in any way.
- 4. Float capacity will not be exceeded.
- 5. Participants will not have body parts, particularly legs and feet, extending past the sides, front or rear of the float. This is an extreme safety hazard.

### LINEUP

- 1. All entries will be assigned a line-up number and receive further instructions about the parade upon receipt and approval of the application.
- 2. Line-up begins at 9am on the corner of East Rd./Forest Rd. at the Atherton's residence.
- 3. Water will be available for participants, as well as port-a-privy use as needed.

**ROUTE** The parade will begin at East Road and Route 31( Forest Road) and continue through the center of Greenfield, to the Hancock extension and finish at Oak Park Parking Lot. FLOATS will be directed to the football field where they can be parked and put on exhibit. Once at the end of the route, you may disband or step aside to allow for the continuance of the parade.
