

The 2.5% increase in the ConVal proposed budget looks like this when it is applied to each of the towns in the ConVal district.

The only way that the budget can be decreased is to come to the deliberative budget meeting on February 6th. It cannot be reduced at the polls on March 12th except to vote for the default budget which won't result in as much of a reduction.

The Selectmen's Advisory Committee is recommending an amendment to the budget to reduce the ConVal School budget by one million dollars for taxpayer relief.
