(Action Taken)

Meninger motioned to open meeting at 7:04 pm. Grim seconds the motion. (Voted: 5-0).

<u>Discussion of request for seasonal waiver on Governors Road Project by Groveland Water Dept. to complete placement of water lines on Governors Road</u>. Present: Tom Cusick

Approaching culvert at 7+00 station, they should be out of that area this week. Highways Dept. has to also do some patching on the road. They are requesting a waiver to at least November 17. The installation of water main will be done this year. New water main will be activated in the Spring 2017.

Grim said the project is a mess. He isn't happy with the erosion controls around the storm drains and by the culvert. We would like it taken care of.

On October 1, we noticed problems with erosion controls and asked the Highway Dept. to put in hay bales which they did. Tom Cusick was unable to address these issues. They started on Monday working on Rollins St. between staging area and culvert – 1 storm drain, culverts, 2 extend10 ft. off Balch Rd.

No plans to go beyond Balch Rd. At 1p.m. on Thursday there is a meeting with Tom Cusick and Bob Arakalian. Perhaps the storm drains and be protected also.

Dempsey suggested granting a waiver until November 30 to insure all work gets completed that needs to be done this year.

Groveland Highway Dept. would like to do more road patch work during this period. Arakalian could not come to the meeting tonight.

(Action Taken)

Schaefer made a motion to grant the waiver for November for work pending placement of erosion controls by November 1st at points noted and identified at the October 27 site visit. Grim second the motion. (Voted: 5-0).

Grim took the plans and he will contact Steve Dehulla about getting plans for the two houses for marker placement. He will contact them and leave plans in the office.
