TOWN OF HADLEY, MASSACHUSETTS SELECT BOARD CONSENT AGENDA Items on a Consent Agenda are exceptions to the general process of the Select Board's Meeting. The Select Board identifies those business items that they believe should generate no controversy and can be properly voted without debate. These items are put on the Consent Agenda to allow motions under these items to be acted upon as one unit and to be passed without debate.

At the call of the Consent Agenda, the Chair of the Select Board will read out the business items, one by one. If one or more Select Board members object to any particular item being included in the Consent Agenda, they say "hold" in a loud voice when the item is called. The item will be removed automatically from the Consent Agenda and voted separately under the usual manner. After the calling of the individual items in the Consent Agenda, the Chair will ask for a motion that the Select Board pass all items remaining <u>AS A UNIT</u> on one vote. Use of the Consent Agenda process makes the Select Board Meeting more efficient by speeding up the handling of non-controversial items.

The Town of Hadley is a member of the Hampshire-Franklin Group Insurance Trust, which provides and administers our employee health insurance program. http://www.hampshirecog.org/programs-and-services/insurance-trust

In order to continue providing high quality health insurance for the future, the Trust is conducting financial planning.

At the Insurance Advisory Committee meeting, the trust is looking for all Units to adopt Section 21-22 of MA General Law 32B by the time the Committee meets again in July.

Notice has been sent to the unions of our intent to consider such adoption. The Select Board will be asked to take formal action to adopt the provisions of MGL Chapter 32B, Section 21-22 at their June 14 meeting.

(1) Advance Notice of Intent to Vote. At least two calendar days in advance of any vote electing to change group health insurance under the process authorized by M.G.L. c. 32B, §§ 21 through 23, the appropriate public authority shall send a notice to each collective bargaining unit to which the authority provides health insurance benefits and to the Retired State, County Municipal Employees Association (RSCME) that the political subdivision intends to vote on whether to implement the process. The vote of the political subdivision under M.G.L. c. 32B, § 21(a) may be in the following form: "The [name of political subdivision] elects to engage in the process to change health insurance benefits under M.G.L. c. 32B, §§ 21 through 23."

Here is the language regarding distribution of the notice of intent to vote:

(a) The advance notice of intent to vote sent by an appropriate pubic authority under 801 CMR 52.02(1) shall be sent: 1. by certified mail, delivery confirmation and return receipt requested; or 2. delivered by hand with a certification of delivery signed by the deliverer, and a copy shall be sent to the Secretary. If the notice is sent by certified mail, either post office evidence of attempted delivery or return receipts shall be prima facie evidence of the time of receipt. The appropriate public authority may include in this notice a statement of its intent to provide further notices by email, along with a requirement that each recipient of the notice provide an email address for future notices. If any recipient of this notice does not provide an email address, the appropriate public authority shall provide notice to that recipient by: a. certified mail, delivery confirmation and return receipt requested; or b. delivery by hand with a certification of delivery signed by the deliverer.
