MINUTES

MEETING OF MARCH 12, 2013, 6:30 PM

ATTENDANCE: Meeting called to order at 6:30 PM. Tom Millias, John Shiavone, Holly Merry and Suzan Duggan present.

1. APPROVE MINUTES OF MEETING OF JANUARY 29, 2013

Motion by Holly Merry, Second John Shiavone to approve minutes of 01/29/13 as written. Vote unanimous.

2. TAKE ACTION ON THE APPEAL OF A FY'13 REAL ESTATE ABATEMENT APPLICATION DENIAL

Motion by Holly Merry, Second John Shiavone to grant appeal of a FY' 13 real estate abatement application previously deemed denied. Vote: yes- John Shiavone and Holly Merry; abstain Tom Millias. Motion approved.

3. TAKE ACTION ON PENDING FY' 13 EXEMPTION APPLICATIONS

Motion by Holly Merry, Second John Shiavone to grant (1) FY' 13 Cl.41C exemption. Vote unanimous.

4. DISCUSS FY 14 ATM BUDGET STATUS, NEW GROWTH

Sue Duggan advised the Board that, to date, New Growth for Real Estate is \$4.8 million in value (\$86,271 in additional levy) for FY'14. Growth for Personal Property has not been calculated yet. This figure is far below last year's growth of \$8.4 million (including Personal Property). The decrease will be primarily due to the near completion of the town-wide Measure & List project which brought in a total of \$2.5 million in value (\$42,000 in levy) for FY'13 alone.

5. DISCUSS STATUS OF PROPOSED SOLAR PROJECT ON MONPONSETT ST. AND MEETING ON FEBRUARY 26 WITH THE DOR REGARDING SOLAR PILOT AGREEMENTS

The Department of Revenue held a Solar Valuation Workshop on February 26th and Sue Duggan, Tom Millias and Holly Merry attended. The speakers were from George E. Sansoucy, P.E., LLC with representatives from the Department of Revenue legal department and the Mass DOE. Assessors were given information regarding the valuation of a solar project and the negotiating of PILOT Agreements. Information provided has been incorporated into the latest draft PILOTAgreement between the Town and Independence Solar.

6. DISCUSS FY '14 REVALUATION UPDATE STATUS

The Town's DOR certification representative will be meeting with Sue Duggan on Thursday, March 14th to begin the FY'14 Revaluation update. The Town is scheduled to have its preliminary values completed by June 18th and ready to be submitted to the DOR for preliminary certification by June 21st.
