They have an existing dwelling on 116 Palmer Mill Rd. and they will use the existing bog road to access the new dwelling. The delineation was done by Brad Holmes, ECR. They have a 50' BVW and the house is fit in with a shoe horn. He knows there is a concern with that. He is volunteering to put up a rail fence on the 50' in the rear of the fence. The Commission agreed to 50' of fence being put up on either side of the house from the back corners to mark the BVW. This lot was not preexisting, it was created last year.

Kendra received a package labeled tree NOI work order. It was reviewed by the Commission and deemed not a valid NOI. Today a violation on Fuller St was received from Frank Kruegger at 25 Fuller St. saying that they were dumping rocks and stones at that location. Per April, this is not acceptable. Please call the Tree Company and place a

Cease and Desist on them. There is no wetland delineation; this is not from DEP, etc. They need to come in and file a valid NOI.
