Update:

Two River Farms Subdivision: The road and sidewalk have been paid. Peter Palmeiri from Merrill Associates was out to inspect. GAF Engineering will be doing the final As-Built specs, and they are preparing to get the road acceptance paperwork completed.

The Building Inspector sent out a letter to the Mobil Station asking to dim the red/green gas pricing sign between dusk & dawn. There were a couple complaints that it was distracting. In the site plan review, the sign company advised it would be dimmed at night and the by-laws state it should be off after hours.

New Business:

Site plan for 69 Summit St. Discussion regarding that, even though he Board does not need to advise abutters about the review, it would be nice to notify them about what is happening. Secretary will write up letter.

Discussions:

Digital signs, look at surrounding towns, and what by-laws they have in place. Mr. Greeley would like to look into signs that are on town property. Board of Selectman have jurisdiction on those signs on town property. A by-law would need to go before Town Meeting for any change. By-law already reads that a sign cannot be on anyone else's property and the Industrial Park can't have two signs or a directory sign. Mr. Andrews again stated that it shouldn't be the position of the board is to make regulations, the job is to enforce it. Would like a committee outside of the board, and be part of, but have input from residents. Notice out to create a By-Law Review Committee, but no residents volunteered.
