10-14 years \$1,200

15-19 years \$1,500

20-24 years \$2,000

25-29 years \$2,500

30+ \$3,000

- ➤ Educational increase \$2,000 for Bachelor's degree
- ➤ 2 more personal days
- > Stipends

Vehicle maintenance \$1,000

Sex Offender Officer \$1,000

Firearms Instructor \$1,000

- > 15 minutes before and 15 minutes after
- Physical fitness incentive (reimbursement yearly gym membership)
- > 3% cost of living pay raise
- > Step 6 for 8 years of continuous service

Seelig has told them that they are not getting the personal day and said he might agree with the longevity if we were giving it to others. He has made a copy for the chief to look at and will review this with Michael Gilman. He said that the officers are fine with the way the department is being run but would like more money.

Millias said that he is getting tired of the stipend request.

As for the educational increase Roy said they just got it and if they were to bring it to Town Meeting the voters will be furious.
