HIGHWAY/CEMETERY CONTRACT

Seelig said that AFSCME has requested that the position of truck driver in the recycling department be added to Highway/Cemetery bargaining unit. He explained that Jason Cowley (recycling truck driver) works three days for Recycling and two days for Highway, thus he is treated as working part-time in both departments but works forty hours weekly. Seelig further said that that bargaining unit for Highway/Cemetery includes only full-time employees. Seelig is not sure if this is Crowley's decision or if the Union is making him join but he can ask him.

Garron suggested getting rid of the Cemetery Department and put it under Highway and Seelig said that we cannot do that yet but maybe at a later time they could.

Millias then asked what is the makeup of the Recycling Center and Seelig said the Highway Surveyor is the department head there.

Seelig suggested that the BOS ask Town Counsel look into this, Garron said to get in touch with Michael Gilman.
