Minutes for March Meeting:

- Joe G. made a motion to accept the minutes as written except for the removal of the New Business section due to an error in the description. The motion was seconded by John K.

Museum- Joe P. reported that he is waiting for three electrical contractors to provide estimates for installing new, more energy efficient and historic looking chandeliers in the museum. The contractors are ArcElectric, Heritage, and Corner Stone Electric. The work would involve 1) removal and disposal of interior present lighting, 2) rewiring, and 3) installation of new lighting fixtures. The lights would be controlled by dimmers. In addition, the exterior lights near the front entrance of the museum would be replaced with period looking motion sensor outdoor wall lights.

Meetinghouse- Rob M. will contact Dave D. soon to see if he is available to meet and discuss options for doing needed work on the floor and ceiling in the kitchen.

- Joe G. stated he going to investigate with the town legal counsel what options are available to the town following the defeat at the March 12th town election of the Warrant Article 20 to make improvements to the parking lot in the Historic District adjacent to the Meetinghouse and Meetinghouse Park.

New Business- John K will contact the Town of Windham's Historic District/Heritage Commission to learn more about the town's project of installing small signs marking historic sites through their town.
