Old Business:

Minutes accepted as corrected; T. Beattie. J. Bohm. Carried

1. Monuments: Chairman received call from individual regarding "sinking" area around monument. J. Bohm suggested checking with undertaker.
2. Markings: G. Swain to mark area for gravestones.
3. Cemetery Entrances: Cemetery roads to re-open given schedule of frost ban.
4. Monies: Mr. Gray received money owed (\$810) following withdrawal of plots. Deed sent to Rockingham Registry of Deeds.
5. Fence Repairs: Project successfully completed by Andy Debenedictus with pressurized lumber. Suggestions for maintenance care in one year included in file. Unanimous vote to have this work done by this contractor in timely fashion. Also noted by contractor that three granite posts have cracks and might need replacement or repair. Trustees agreed to have Ghlee Woodworth apprise situation.

New Business:

1. Lawn Care: Following discussion, a motion was made by J. Bohm and seconded by T. Beattie to award contract to Going Green, Owner Brian O'Neil, for \$27 K. This amount to include Spring and Fall cleanup with the right to terminate without cause. Passed
2. T. Beattie received word from a towns person regarding Brookside cemetery. The concern was three fold: a/ location of back boundary b/; can anything be done about brush/tree growth, etc and would a bench be allowed in cemetery. The Trustees decided to take a field trip through all Town cemeteries for the purpose of observing their current state and locate boundaries. It was agreed that benches should be permissible and The By Laws now reflect this addition: Section 3, page 5 - last paragraph; "Monuments, including benches...." T. Beattie will convey this to the resident. The walk is scheduled for [redacted] prior to regular meeting.
