New Business:

Members of the Select-board were interested in talking with the commission about the possibility of using a small area at the Raspberry Farm to be used as a playing field. Neither select-board member was present at the meeting, so no discussion took place. S. Hanson will review the Conservation Easement of the Raspberry Farm to determine if that type of use is allowed.

The Application request for jurisdictional wetland impacts for Map 1 Lot 98-3 (Goodwin rd) was is a renewal request from a 2007 application submitted to NHDES. S. Hanson spoke to NHDES but no other details were given on the project other than to say the request was to renew what was granted back in 2007 for that same property.

Students at LAS will be displaying the posters they've produced working with the UNH extension (Amanda Stone) in regard to how climate change is effecting communities in NH. This presentation will be April 19th Wednesday at 6pm.

The Commission discussed changing the monthly meeting day from the second Thursday to either the second Tuesday or Wednesday due to the fact the Thursday night meeting conflicts with the School Board meeting. S. Hanson will communicate with the Commission to determine what day works best, and will communicate this with the Town Administrator.
