Update on long range planning: J. Kibler and S. Hanson obtained an undated map of all conservation and town owned land in Hampton Falls from the RPC, this map is dated 2013. We also obtained a copy of all land which is coded as being in "current use" so that we can highlight the map with those lots that are in current use. This map will be used to create a list of land that would be good to consider conserving as well as a list of characteristics of each lot regarding what makes it a good candidate for conservation. (water, wildlife, other resources).
