Committee members met on site to measure and attempt to identify the location of an iron pin boundary marker. The location of this pin is needed in order to determine whether a driveway can be placed on Town property to access the back area of the park currently being considered for shared parking by the Hampton Falls Baptist Church and patrons of the playing fields at Gov. Weare Park.

Measurements were identified and approximate locations staked, however, no iron pin was found. It was determined that Altus Engineering, the surveyor who prepared the plans for Gov. Weare Park, will be contacted for a price to review and re-confirm the corner boundary markers.

L. Smith will bring the matter of survey costs to the Parks and Recreation Commission for consideration.
